MP Kramp: Government of Canada supports accessibility for all Canadians

Belleville, ON— Daryl Kramp, Member of Parliament for Prince Edward-Hastings, on behalf of the Honourable Diane Finley, Minister of Human Resources and Skills Development, today invited organizations to apply for grants of up to \$50,000 for projects that will improve accessibility for people with disabilities that will enable them to participate fully in their communities.

“The Government of Canada supports Canadians living with disabilities. The Enabling Accessibility Fund allows us to fund projects which improve access to facilities, services and activities”, said Mr. Kramp.

Organizations can submit proposals until September 23, 2011, under the Fund’s Small Projects component. Small projects may include renovation, construction and retrofitting of buildings, modification of vehicles for community use, or enhancements to make information and communication technologies more accessible.

The following types of organizations may apply:

- Not-for-profit organizations,
- Small municipalities (with a population under 250,000 as per census data),
- Small private-sector organizations (fewer than 50 employees and under \$5 million in gross revenue per year),
- Colleges and universities,
- Territorial governments, and
- Aboriginal governments.
