GOVERNMENT PARTNERS CELEBRATE RECREATIONAL REHABILITATION PROJECT

Prince Edward-Hastings: — Prince Edward-Hastings Member of Parliament, Daryl Kramp and Member of Provincial Parliament, Leona Dombrowsky today joined Municipality of Hastings Highlands Mayor, Ron Emond, to celebrate the completion upgrades to Bird's Creek Community Centre Sports Park. This project received joint federal, provincial and municipal funding of \$49,824 each, (\$149,472 total) to improve community recreational infrastructure, announced last year under the Recreational Infrastructure Canada program in Ontario (RIInC Ontario) and Recreation Ontario (Ontario REC).

"The rehabilitation of our sports parks will provide Hastings Highlands residents with modern, accessible recreational facilities that will serve them for years to come", said Mr. Kramp. "Our government is investing in recreational facilities to create jobs and improve the quality of life in communities across Ontario."

Projects like the rehabilitation of Bird's Creek Community Centre Sports Park provide stimulus to the local economy through investments that spur construction activity related to recreational infrastructure. Improving recreational facilities and services also encourages higher levels of participation in physical activity and community building.

"In this final year of the Economic Action Plan, we are also seeing projects like the Bird's Creek Community Centre reach completion, providing real and tangible examples of our investments at work", added Mr. Kramp.
