Municipal office replacement project helps boost economy and create jobs: Kramp

Centre Hastings – Today, Daryl Kramp, Member of Parliament for Prince Edward-Hastings, along with Municipal and Provincial officials, celebrated the completion of a project which included the replacement of The Centre Hastings Municipal Office and Council Chambers.

The project was made possible because of a \$630,000 grant from the Federal and Provincial Governments' through the Infrastructure Stimulus Fund (ISF).

On June 5, 2009, Canada and Ontario announced a joint investment of \$1.85 billion for infrastructure projects intended to create jobs and stimulate the economy.

Through Canada's Economic Action Plan, the federal government established a \$4-billion Infrastructure Stimulus Fund that provides funding to construction-ready infrastructure projects.

Through the Government of Ontario's 2009 provincial budget, *Confronting the Challenge: Building Our Economic Future*, Ontario has allocated funding to match federal infrastructure stimulus investments in the province.

“I am pleased to be here today on behalf of the Government of Canada to celebrate the completion of this infrastructure project”, said MP Kramp. “Creating and maintaining jobs and boosting the prosperity of Canadian communities and municipalities are priorities for our government during these fragile economic times. ”
