**MP Kramp: Government Investment in clean air makes us breathe easier**

**Belleville, ON-** Daryl Kramp, Member of Parliament for Prince Edward-Hastings applauds today's announcement by Environment Minister Peter Kent of an investment of \$600.8 million over five years to renew the Clean Air Regulatory Agenda, (CARA), which has served as the framework for the Government to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve air quality since 2006.

"Our government is committed to protecting Canadian's health and the environment in which we live", said Mr. Kramp. "Improving our air quality will benefit the overall well-being of Canadians".

This funding will be used by the Government of Canada to:

- Align greenhouse gas regulations with the United States where appropriate;
- Finalize and implement a national air quality management system;
- Strengthen commitments to reduce transboundary air pollution under the Canada-U.S. Air Quality Agreement;
- Improve indoor air quality; and,
- Nation-wide implementation of the Air Quality Health Index to help Canadians make informed decisions to protect their health.
