### **MP Kramp: Recent Government funding protects Canadian's health**

Belleville, Ontario – Daryl Kramp, Member of Parliament for Prince Edward-Hastings, welcomes two recent funding initiatives by the Canadian Government to protect the health of Canadian families.

The Government of Canada announced funding this week for the creation of The Canadian Network for Observational Drug Effect Studies (CNODES). This network will bring together more than 60 researchers from across Canada to conduct independent research to confirm that prescription drugs are effective and safe. The Government of Canada has committed \$17.5 million over five years to support CNODES.

Also announced this week is an investment of \$6 million in 37 new community based projects as part of the Canadian Diabetes Strategy. These projects will offer Canadians information, tools and resources to aid in the early detection and management of diabetes and related complications.

“Our government is working to improve the lives of Canadians”, said Mr. Kramp. “These investments protect our health and furthermore stimulate jobs and growth in the medical sector across the country.”
