MOHAWKS OF THE BAY OF QUINTE CELEBRATE LOCAL UPGRADES TO SPORTS COMPLEX

Deseronto, ON – Today, Daryl Kramp, Member of Parliament for Prince Edward–Hastings celebrated the beginning of construction of the Karonhyak’tatye Sports Complex and Skateboard Park and the completion of the Karonhyak’tatye Sports Complex Baseball Diamond upgrades.

The Karonhyak’tatye Sports Complex and Skateboard Park construction and Ball Diamond upgrades were funded under the Recreational Infrastructure Canada (RinC) program.

Work on the new skateboard park consists of engineering, design, site preparation and construction. The governments of Canada and Ontario have each committed up to \$162,917 to the project. The Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte will contribute the balance of the total eligible project cost of up to \$488,750.

Upgrades to the baseball diamonds included infield reconstruction, fence repairs, new bleachers and new digital scoreboards. The governments of Canada and Ontario have each committed up to \$44,774 to the project. The Mohawks of the Bay of Quinte will contribute the balance of the total eligible project cost of up to \$134,322.

“Investing in recreation facilities ensure that our communities remain safe, accessible and vibrant places for residents to live, work and play”, said Mr. Kramp. “These projects will allow local youth to express themselves through sports and encourage residents to stay active and healthy”.

Since 2007, the governments of Canada and Ontario have committed more than \$13 billion in funding to more than 6,400 infrastructure projects across the province.
