MP KRAMP WELCOMES LAUNCH OF SUMMER JOBS 2010

Belleville – Member of Parliament for Prince Edward-Hastings, Daryl Kramp, is pleased to announce to his constituents that Canada Summer Jobs program has now been officially launched for 2010.

“Canada Summer Jobs meets the needs of students and also supports organizations that play a key role in our communities”, said Mr. Kramp. “The experience and learning that young people gain by working in these jobs gives them a head start in the workforce later on in their lives.”

Canada Summer Jobs is a Government of Canada initiative that provides funding to help employers create summer job opportunities for students and is designed to focus on local priorities, while achieving tangible results for both students and communities.

Funding will be offered to not-for-profit public-sector and small private-sector employers to create high quality summer job opportunities for young people 15 to 30 years old who are full-time students and intend to return to school in the next school year.
