Government of Canada Invests in Bancroft Area Youth

Bancroft, Ontario – On behalf of the Honourable Diane Finley, Minister of Human Resources & Skills Development Canada, Daryl Kramp, Member of Parliament (Prince Edward–Hastings), today announced funding of \$213,040 for Bancroft area youth who are looking to learn valuable employability skills.

The Training Education and Careers Havelock (TEACH) Centre’s Youth Wise North Hastings “Skills Link Project”, will identify 12 rural youth and, over the course of 28 weeks, will help them develop and enhance life and employability skills and gain work experience.

“There are many young people, who due to their lack of skills or even labour market barriers, are at risk for finding meaningful employment”, said Mr. Kramp. “I’m pleased that our government is supporting the Skills Link Project which will help some of them make better lives for themselves which will ultimately benefit the communities in which they live.”
